Treasurer's Report	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. PAC Account. Expenses are trending as expected and revenues are currently 13% higher than budget. Investment option is a 14-month GIC with an interest rate of 1.24%. Open discussion on value of securing funds versus availability of capital given nominal interest rate. 2. Wish List funds. As of the end of March the PAC has reimbursed 70% (82% to include the high jump matt) of approved wish list items. If any teacher's no longer require the items, please just let us know so we can reallocate funds. 3. Gaming Account. We've allocated the annual field trip costs as well as the PAC portion of the school-wide in-line sports activity, scholarships, and the Fine Arts Performances. 4. School and District PAC Accounts. 2016-17 Teacher Discretionary and Field Trip funds are in these school account and being managed by Cindy, the head secretary of Crescent 	Katherine Botelho raised a motion to not put funds into a locked in GIC. Motion passed unanimously.
