Report is from DPAC'S last meeting Playgrounds

Discussion by another school in the district around how funds are allotted for playgrounds. Here are some notes if we want to proceed with the Turf field. Key takeaway is that once the school and PAC agree to move forward you need to contact district.
o School District facilities keep a list of schools that need playgrounds and submit it to the Province.

- 25 Schools were approved last year, Holly Elementary was the only one picked in Surrey.
o If PAC is raising money for one, the school administration needs to make sure the District is contacted to ensure that facilities are aware
