BUDGET COMMENTS / QUESTIONS:

Babysitters Course

KB - is it funded by PAC?

BW - No, volunteers needed.

JH - offer it to the right grade, and do a sign up sheet in the classes.

10K Computers & Tech

CL - what is the school's wishlist Jolene?

JE - laptops - 30 x 1500 x 8 = \$360K

Currently there's one FULL set of laptops, ipads upstairs 1 full set of ipads and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a cart on the main floor 1 full set of ipads and $\frac{1}{2}$ set of a cart downstairs

Current fund will go to lpads

Emergency Kit

KM - are there items that need to be replenished?

JE - Yes, granola bars, perishable food, batteries

JS - Are the locks sorted out?

JE - Adrian had a locksmith come in, still getting sorted out

AM - Do we have to replenish the kit every year?

KB - Can we donate the batteries to Riverdale?

AM - Haven't replaced the first aid kits, so we'll need to replace those soon.

AM - Can we do \$2K for the budget?

KB - ask for donations from the families

CL - if donations given, can the school give out a tax receipt?

JE - No, only if it's given through the district, but there's a lot of red tape, and there's no control from a PAC level. The district can redirect the funds at their discretion (85% / 15%)

AM - Does the school have a defib?

JE - No, someone has to be trained on them, and they need to be serviced

Fun Fair

JS - is the funfair a fundraiser?

BW - you pay a family admission, everything is included

KM - can't guarantee what you're going to bring in

BW - keep it simple; cake walk, games, cotton candy machine, \$40 per family, get a hotdog, cotton candy, activities

Dates to be determined, sometime in JUNE

JE - The Friday evening, not a Saturday or long weekend and on school grounds

BW - more parent volunteers, more community based

SE - suggestion - each grade comes up with different games; cheap and inexpensive,

RM - add in soccer and games

Garden Budget

PAC - Increase to \$250 from \$0

BW - turf and drainage - potential donor, will circle back

JS - Does the district take care of the maintenance?

JE - Not funded by the district currently

RM - is it the bins in the back?

JE - there is a plot in the community garden, large pots in the front with the potatoes; one of the the teachers wants to plant bulbs in the old fairy garden.

KB - call to parents to donate or head a seed swap

SE - use it as a fundraiser

ASQ - pac here to support every idea and fundraiser, we'll get it out there on behalf of the pac

KB - instead of having it as a line item, maybe make it a non-pac item

PAC - VOTE TO take out the \$250

In-line Skating

JE - cost has gone up to \$6k, the school has to supplement the difference in the school if it's offered by the school.

Movie Night

BW - is it free to have it at school?

JE - yes, except for the associated costs

- buy concession items to sell at the movie night
- associated costs with which movie
- if it's purchased, then there's no licensing

Santa Breakfast - 19 Dec 2024

BW - new contacts

JS - will donate the use of her personal griddle for the event, as their family has in the past

BW - Anneke & Amber are the leads

Student Education Fund

BW - hip hop dance, duffle bag theatre, tennis

JS - Can we rent out the tennis courts through the city?

JE - Yes we can

Teachers Appreciation - END OF MAY

JH - Suggestion to talk to EMF to find out if we can get a deal from Cactus

SE - she volunteered to cook a meal for the teachers. She did it once a month at her kiddos old school for the teachers. Volunteering to lead it for 45 teachers & staff.

ASQ - keep the budget as is, the balance will be kept in the pot

Teachers Fund

JE - 14 classes. music. IST. LST

BW - Mrs. R has asked to have a budget for her program that supports neurodivergent students throughout the day.

RM - What's the process if the teachers want the funds?

JE - they approach Jolene, and Jolene to the PAC
